2015 League Match Play Tournament Etiquette and Rules

1.0 GENERAL

The Ain Nakhl Golf Club will have season long Match Play Tournament. The Match Play Tournament will be for singles matchplay.

The Tournament is open to all Ain Nakhl Golf Club members in good standing...there are no handicap cutoffs.

2.0 SINGLES NET TOURNAMENT

Player bracket seeding (positions) will be selected randomly by the Tournament Director. Contenders will play using 100% of their latest posted handicap on the day of the match.

The entries will be split into two leagues. Each player will play all other players in their league. Each match must be played within the calendar month. Failure to arrange the match will result in a win for the opponent who was available on the day of the match

The scoring will be 2 points for a win, 1 point for a draw and -1 point for a loss. Players who win their game with four holes or more remaining will receive a bonus point.

USGA and local rules will apply during all matches.

3.0 SCHEDULING

It is left to the Competitors to agree on the date and time to play the match game and they should inform the Tournament Director of the schedule before the match. If possible, play the match on the agreed weekend for the league matchplay. All rounds of the competition should be played on or before the final day of the month that the match is scheduled to play.

Failure to arrange a match should be reported to the tournament director who will assess the result. **The intention is to pay all matches and have fun a catch up month will be allowed for matches that were not played however this will only be used as a last resort by the tournament director.**

4.0 INELIGIBILITY

Match Play competitions are not permitted to be played during Stroke Play events. USGA Rule 33-1 states “that certain special rules governing stroke play are so substantially different from those governing match play that combining the two forms is not practicable and is not permitted. The results of matches played and the scores returned in these circumstances must not be accepted”.

5.0 DISPUTES

All disputes, whether in schedule or play, should be brought to the attention of the Tournament Director to see if an equitable solution can be worked out. If not, then the issue can be elevated to the Board for resolution. However, unless there are extenuating circumstances, then the most probable decision would be to disqualify both players/teams.

6.0 PRIZES

Prizes and trophies for the league matchplay will be determined by the Board and presented at the end of year dinner.
